Dear Nursery Parents,

From time to time children at school do not always manage to make it to the toilet!

On these occasions the staff will make sure that they are cleaned and have dry underwear. (It is useful if you pop a pair of pants into their red bags in case we need them, although we do have fresh underwear in school.)

If a child does have an accident our policy is that we pop the soiled underwear into a blue plastic bag and tie it onto the outside of their red bags. We do not make a fuss about it.

This is a Health and Safety procedure to keep the soiled articles away from items in the bag and to alert you to the fact that underwear has been changed. Staff will endeavour to speak to you personally in this event.

If your child does have any problems with toilet issues (as some children do) our School Nurse Karon Halliday is available to give advice.
